

PARIS HAUTE COUTURE FOR CHOPARD EXPERIENCE

1. The Paris Haute Couture For Chopard Experience ("**Gift**") is available to buy by one (1) customer ("**Customer**") from NET-A-PORTER'S website (the "**Website**") and provides the Customer with an experience with Chopard (the "**Jeweller**") which shall comprise of:
 - a. a preview for two (2) people (the Customer and one (1) guest) of the Jeweller's Haute Joaillerie collection (the "**Collection Preview**") and an invitation for the Customer and one (1) guest to attend the Jeweller's VIP Dinner with Caroline Scheufele, artistic director and co-President of the Jeweller (the "**Dinner**"), both taking place in Paris during the Paris Haute Couture week ("**Couture Week**");
 - b. the assistance of a NET-A-PORTER Personal Shopper, such Personal Shopper to be allocated at NET-A-PORTER's discretion, to assist in the curation of the Customer's Couture Week wardrobe (the "**PS Meeting**"). Any items purchased through the Personal Shopper are excluded from the Gift and shall be purchased separately by the Customer. The PS Meeting may happen in person or via telephone or email. If in person, travel to and from the PS Meeting shall be excluded from the Gift and other exclusions may apply but will be communicated to the Customer as and when they enquire about booking the PS Meeting;
 - c. a visit, for the Customer only, to the Jeweller's Atelier in Geneva ("**Atelier Visit**"); and
 - d. one (1) bespoke Chopard piece (the "**Item**") up to the Gift's Value (as defined below) (inclusive of VAT (where applicable) or plus any other sales tax and/or customs duties where due), which shall be created specifically for the Customer by the Jeweller and will involve the Customer meeting with a representative from the Jeweller in order to design the Item (as described in further detail below).
2. In consideration for the Gift, the Customer shall pay:
 - a. the "**Initial Deposit**", being £200,000 GBP which shall be the deposit towards the Gift's Value (as defined below) which shall be paid by the Customer prior to the Appointment (as defined below); and
 - b. the "**Outstanding Cost**", being the outstanding amount due for the Gift which shall be calculated as the difference between the Initial Deposit and the Value. The Value shall mean the total price that the Customer will pay for the Item, once the Customer has agreed on all their requirements for the Item with the Jeweller. Details of the Value shall be communicated to the Customer by NET-A-PORTER following the Customer's Appointment with the Jeweller.
3. The Customer's Personal Shopper shall liaise with the Customer and the Jeweller to confirm the date, time and location of the Dinner, the Atelier Visit and the Appointment.
4. The Dinner's location shall be at the discretion of the Jeweller, and shall be booked and paid for by the Jeweller (and is included in the Gift). It shall be the Customer's responsibility to notify the restaurant for the Dinner of any allergies that they or their guest may have prior to the Dinner.
5. The cost of travel for the Customer (and their guest, if applicable) to and from the Collection Preview and Dinner in Paris, as well as any overnight accommodation, is not included in the Gift and are the Customer's responsibility to organise and pay for.
6. As part of the Gift, the Customer will have one (1) appointment with the Jeweller in Geneva, the date, time and duration of which shall be at the Jeweller's sole discretion (the "**Appointment**"). During the Appointment, the Customer shall:
 - a. meet a representative from the Jeweller;
 - b. have a tour of the design and production facilities; and
 - c. design the Item.
7. The Appointment will be scheduled by the NET-A-PORTER Personal Shopping Team, who will also attend in person, and is subject to the Jeweller's availability. If, for any reason, the Customer is unable to attend the scheduled Appointment, this can be rescheduled if the Customer provides at least one (1) months' notice. If the Customer fails to provide the required notice, then whilst the NET-A-PORTER Personal Shopping Team will use its reasonable efforts to reschedule the Appointment, there is no guarantee that this will be possible and, if not, then the Customer will be taken to have forfeited this element of the Gift.
8. In designing the Item, the Customer may select from design options which are priced in line with the Initial Deposit and then work with the Jeweller to add bespoke elements to the Item. All bespoke

elements shall be subject to availability. In the event that a particular element is not available, then the Jeweller will consult the Customer to offer the next best substitute of equivalent value.

9. The cost of travel for the Customer to and from Geneva in order to attend the Atelier Visit and Appointment, and any overnight accommodation, is not included in the Gift and is the Customer's responsibility to organise and pay for.
10. Each Customer (and their guest, if applicable) is responsible for ensuring that they have any and all necessary travel documentation, visas and insurance in order to travel to Paris and/or Geneva. NET-A-PORTER will not be liable if a Customer (or their guest, if applicable) is unable to attend the Collection Preview, Dinner, Atelier Visit or Appointment through failing to comply with this condition.
11. The Gift is non-transferable, non-exchangeable and no cash alternative is offered, meaning that the Value cannot be applied to any other item, other than the Item designed by the Customer in collaboration with the Jeweller.
12. The Item is expressly excluded from NET-A-PORTER's usual returns and exchange policy as it is a bespoke item.
13. The Gift is personal to each Customer and is purchased for private (not commercial) use.
14. The Customers may be required to participate in publicity in connection with the Gift.
15. Images of the Gift in the product description are for illustration purposes only.
16. Once having purchased the Gift, each Customer will be contacted by the NET-A-PORTER Personal Shopping Team who will work with the Customer to assist them organising the various elements of the Gift.
17. The Gift must be redeemed within one (1) year from the date of purchase.
18. Delivery costs associated with the Item will be complimentary but please note that exclusions may apply.
19. NET-A-PORTER reserves the right to cancel the Gift if it feels that a Customer has violated any of these terms.
